Background information

Common to 3 organisations – Eurostat/UNECE/ITF

Detailled data for :

• 4 inland transport statistics

Rail, Road, Inland waterways and Pipeline transport

• 5 themes

Infrastructure, transport equipment, enterprises, traffic and transport measurment



What does it offer

- Core detailled transport information supported by the 3 Organisations
- Variables defined in the « Glossary for transport statistics »
- Consistent and harmonised transport data
- Hundreds of historical series for international data comparison
- Great potential to calculate/derive transport indicators
- Available on a web site hosted by Eurostat (to facilite access process and checks)



Not all ITF countries complete it

□Curently used for the 58 UNECE countries (which include all Eurostat and European ITF countries

□We should include all our members in this data collection

- To enable a broader scope of transport data analysis
- To offer a platform with a global view on transport statistics



Next Steps

- Technically we will be ready this fall
- To reduce the burden we will produce a light version of the questionnaire
- This has to be aggreed by the 3 organisations (talks going on)
- This remains a voluntary data collection
- USA and Canada already complete it
- We need all the other non european ITF members to join
