GENERAL REMARKS

Regulation (EC) No 1071/2009 is a legal act of the European Union, which become immediately enforceable as law in all member states simultaneously.

The relating provisions of Regulation (EC) No 1071/2009 were directly converted into Austrian law. Respective provisions of the federal laws GütbefG, GelverkG and KflG (see the Glossary) have been amended https://www.ris.bka.gv.at/eli/bgbl/I/2013/32/

General remark on the competent Authorities:

According to §27 of GütbefG (Federal Law on Goods Transport), the competent authorities for all the stipulations mentioned here are 1) the Federal Ministry of Federal Ministry for Climate Action, Environment, Energy, Mobility, Innovation and Technology and 2) the Federal Ministry of Economy and Labour. All the mentioned national laws are federal laws.

Due to the organisation and structure of the authorities in Austria the competent authorities for all the stipulations of the Quality Charter are the local authorities, i.e. <u>authority for local districts</u> (<u>Bezirksverwaltung</u>). These authorities are provincial organs located in the local district capitals (Bezirks-Hauptstadt) acting, however, on behalf of the Federal Government as the laws they execute are federal.

This administration procedure is called "indirect federal administration" (mittelbare Bundesverwaltung). This concerns establishment of enterprise and granting/withdrawal of licenses. Some of the stipulations will be executed by the police (which might be federal or provincial) - mostly road side checks in cooperation with federal testing institutions (technical checks). In case of infringement the case will be transferred to the local district authority for imposing a sanction – either financial fee or withdrawal of licence. In case of punishment the delinquent has the right to appeal in federal courts.

All 43 Member Countries participating in the ECMT Multilateral Quota are parties to the European Agreement concerning the Work of Crews of Vehicles Engaged in International Road Transport (AETR) dated 1 July 1970. In the course of any international road haulage operation carried out under an ECMT licence, the undertaking and members of the crew must comply with the provisions laid down by the AETR with regard to the duration of driving and rest times and crew composition [It is understood that compliance with these provisions are monitored through National procedures, established for the purpose of implementing the AETR or equivalent regulations].
